On Kristallnacht, November 9–10, 1938, Nazis in Germany, Austria and Sudetenland torched synagogues, vandalized Jewish homes and businesses and killed close to 100 Jews.



Ruth Mondschein Zimbler was born in Vienna, Austria in 1928. Several months after the German annexation of Austria, Ruth and her brother, Walter, watched the destruction of the largest synagogue in Vienna from their apartment on November 10, 1938, during Kristallnacht. Concerned about their children's safety Ruth's parents sent Ruth and her brother on the first Kindertransport out of Vienna. Ruth and her family eventually made it to safety in New York City in late 1939.
